Passenger Briefing

- Obey all flight crew instructions
- Smoking in or near aircraft prohibited
- Safety belts and shoulder harness required
- Stow personal items/equipment
- Do not interfere with pilot or flight controls
- Bend at the waist while approaching or departing
- Never allow poles, umbrellas, or any objects to contact rotors
- Electronic devices off

Survival

- Ditching procedures / Egress
- Water survival equipment
- Personal Flotation Device (PFD)

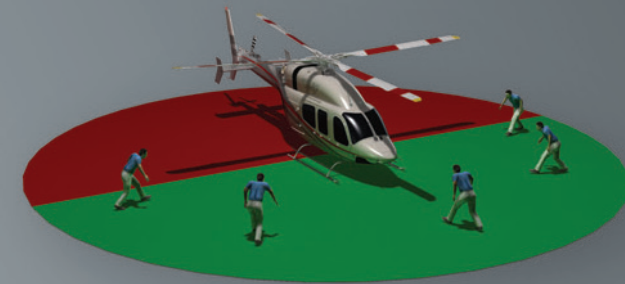
Tail Rotor

- Never approach



Approaching and Departing Aircraft

- Observe the position of rotor blades
- Make eye contact with pilot before approaching
- Bend at the waist - lower your profile
- Approach from the front
- Do not go behind the helicopter
- Do not exit the helicopter until rotor blades have stopped
